Qualifications:

- A clear understanding of the operation of vacuum trucks or similar equipment
- A valid Class 5 license
- Successful completion of a pre-employment background check, and substance abuse screening test
- Show a strong work ethic, positive attitude and reliability

Responsibilities:

- Complying with Pride Hydrovac's HSE Manual and all applicable legislations related to this position.
- Working cooperatively under the guidance of a qualified operator.
- Participate in all pre-job hazard assessments and inspections prior to commencing any job.
- Work safely during all phases of performing the job duties required in the field.
- Ability to follow directions both written and verbal; read/speak and understand English; read and understand common danger placards/labels and hazardous warning literature including site safety plans.
- Must be able to understand and comply with company and client safety standards.
- Must have the ability to work independently.
- Must have basic mechanical knowledge and skills for on road small trouble shooting and repairs.
- Complete all required paperwork in an accurate and timely manner.
- Project work may require travel out of home town for two weeks or more.
- Work outside year-round for long hours in all types of weather.
- May work in environments that are extreme in nature or environmental conditions such as heat, cold, heights, confined spaces, hazardous areas, loud noises, dangerous equipment, long hours, etc.
- May be exposed to varying levels of physical activities and physical extremes such as long periods of standing, walking, crouching, use of hands, heavy lifting of up to 50 pounds or more.
- Maintain and use appropriate personal protective equipment.
- Must always be clean shaven to allow for immediate donning and seal of respirator equipment if necessary.

Housekeeping:

- **All crew members are responsible for proper clean up of rig when a job is complete.**
- Responsible for proper load securement of any hoses, chemical pails or other equipment.
- Assist in ensuring that the unit is stocked and has the equipment necessary to keep truck in good working order.
